- The Exodus begins, and with it, the grumbling
- Manna from heaven
- “Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.”
- Gouging out an eye to save us from the “fire of hell”?
- “For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”
