

Week 6: February 10 (Feb. 3–Feb. 9)

- Moses assembles the first group of Elders
- They arrive at Mt. Sinai
- God calls the children of Israel to the mountain
- Thunder, lightning and smoke: is this the OT God?
- God gives Moses the 10 Commandments
- On tablets, written by God, words on both sides
- You shall not “murder” or “kill” - is there a difference?
- The people fear God: “speak to us yourself and we will listen. But do not have God speak to us or we will die.”
- An “eye-for-an-eye” - taken from the Code of Hammurabi?
- “Do not mistreat or oppress a foreigner”
- “Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong”
- Constructing the Ark of the Covenant and the Tabernacle
- Aaron and his sons as the priests
- The Pharisees follow the Sadducees in testing Jesus
- “You have neglected justice, mercy and faithfulness.”
- The coming of the end: the meaning of the word “apocalypse”
- “Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things happen...”
- “Therefore, keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come.”
- “Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them.”
- Separating the sheep from the goats - what is the point of this story: “whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me. Whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.”
- Judas prepares to betray Jesus, for 30 pieces of silver
- Jesus shares the bread and cup
- “My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will.”
- Proverbs 8: the creation of Wisdom (Woman Wisdom)
