- Leviticus continues to lay out rules/regulations/laws
- Aaron’s sons Nadab and Abihu die – why?
- Don’t eat these: lobster, scallops, clams, oysters, crab
- Lepers are to shout out “unclean, unclean!”
- “The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath.”
- Jesus’ family: “he is out of his mind”
- “If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand”
- Blaspheme against the Holy Spirit - unforgivable?
- Jesus responds: “Who are my mother and my brothers?”
- The parable of the sower and the seeds
- Putting the impure spirit in the pigs: “the people began to plead with Jesus to leave their region.”
- “A prophet is not without honor except in his own town, among his relatives, and in his own home.”
- “He was amazed at their lack of faith”
- The feeding of the 5,000/15,000 - what is the miracle?
- Psalm 37 - “Do not fret because of those who are evil or be envious of those who do wrong; for like the grass they will soon wither...Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him...The meek will inherit the land...”
